The Year of Mercy Plenary Indulgence

The Plenary Indulgence can be attained by the faithful who are truly repentant and fulfil the following conditions:

- Receiving sacramental confession
- Receiving Holy Communion
- Praying the Creed, the Our Father and the Hail Mary for the intentions of the Holy Father

If you fulfil the above conditions, you will receive a Plenary Indulgence when you perform a brief pilgrimage to the Holy Door in one of the designated places:

- Arundel Cathedral
- Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation, West Grinstead
- Church of Christ the Prince of Peace, Weybridge
- Mayfield Convent Chapel [by appointment]
- Any of the Holy Doors such as Westminster Cathedral or any of the four Papal Basilicas in Rome

There is alternative provision for those who are unable to leave their location through illness, age or any other cause.

The Icon of Our Lady of Consolation will travel around the Diocese from its present Shrine in West Grinstead. It will be visiting the Parishes of the Mayfield Deanery during the week beginning 8th February and will spend a day in each Parish Church.
