<u>Baptism</u>	Sundays at 12 noon, unless during the MASS. By appointment with Fr Kevin.
<u>Marriage</u>	By appointment with Fr Kevin. In this Diocese one year's notice is required in normal circumstances. A Marriage Preparation Course is also required.

Note from the Parish Finance and Maintenance Committee: Some Parishioners may have noticed that cameras have been fitted in locations within the Church premises. This is a recent installation agreed by the Parish Finance and Maintenance Committee to improve security as well as address Health and Safety considerations. It means that parts of our premises can be checked on a monitor located within the Cottage and also allows recordings to be made.

The intention is to extend this facility so that services conducted in the Church may also be seen on a screen to be fitted in the Parish Room and this will be particularly useful when the number of people attending a service is such that some have to spill over into the Parish Room.
